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

I. NAME.

The name of the Society shall be "ADIVASI NAVJEEWAN GATHAN NAVJYOTI AGUA", however hereafter called ANGNA.

II. ADDRESS.

The registered office of the society i.e. ANGNA shall be located at: ANGNA Kahupani

III. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES.

The aims and objectives of the Society are as hereunder:

A. To disseminate and promote Rural Development for the development and growth of the ADIVASIS (TRIBALS) and the socially and economically weaker and backward sections of the community.

Addl. Registrate. To undertake all things necessary for Rural Development, social, Sundargari economical, cultural, religious and secular knowledge among the people without any discrimination of caste creed community or religion and for the matter.

A. Rural development.

- 1. To undertake, carry out, promote, or aid directly or indirectly any activities for the promotion and growth of rural economy and welfare or other programmes for building up the rural people towards self sufficiency.
- 2. To undertake all agricultural activities, educate and create awareness among villagers for the best utilization of land, water and animals wealth.

- 3. To encourage, assist and carry out all types of agricultural, horticultural, fishery, animal husbandary and social forestry programmes among the economically weaker section of the people.
- 4. To encourage, assist and promote modern technology in the field of agriculture, horticulture, fishery, animal husbandary and social forestry for the rural development.
- 5. To encourage, assist and undertake all agricultural activities to produce more food grains, vegetables and oil seeds pulses and assist farmers to market their product in the market and for this matter as and when necessary to make multipurpose co-operative societies for the purpose.
- 6. To establish and promote cottage industries, agrobased industries and vocational training institutions for the same purpose and create employment opportunities for unemployed youths and to bring self sufficiency among rural people.
- 7. To organize and conduct seminars, meetings, lectures, conferences, workshops, discussions and to publish and circulate such materials in medias such as News bulletin, magazines, circulars, articles, books and pamphlets in consonance to the spirits and objectives of the society.
- 8. To establish and administer formal and non-formal educational institutions, schools, colleges, orphanages, universities, vocational and Registrations centres, hostels and other institutions of allied or like Sandargarbnature within the district of Sundargarh.
 - 9. To undertake and establish different types of communities health care programmes, mother and child care among the rural poor.
 - 10. To organize cultural festivals, cultural programmes, children's fair, sports and games, study tour for students and farmers and talent development programmes to make rural people aware of their problems rights and duties.
 - 11. To encourage and prepare rural youth to eradicate social evils of the society and take lead in the building up of their village communities in all spheres of life: social, economical, religious, cultural, educational etc.

- 12. To encourage, assist and undertake business and marketing programmes for rural youths for employment generations and for the economic building of the rural people.
- 13. To organize and provide relief services to the needy coffeeted by natural calamities, famines, flood, fire, earth quake etc.
- 14. To seek affiliation to any organization, federation or Body having all or any of the aims and objectives of the society if seen fit, necessary and conductive.
- 15. To co-operate, assist, encourage any programmes for rural development undertake by Government Agencies or Non-Government Agencies or private or public persons.
- 16. To make representations to the Government and other public Authorities on the matter concerning rural problems.
- 17. To undertake and foster village community buildings to bring peace and harmony in the village.

b. Property.

- 1. To acquire lands through purchase gifts, lease or otherwise and/or buildings and premises or any other properties movable or immovable for the furtherance and attainments of the objectives of the society.
- 2. To get mutated (in revenue or tahsil court) all the immovable properties of the society and establishment in the individual or joint names of the society.

c.Finance.

- 1. To receive donations, bequests, subscriptions, gifts and contributions whether in cash or kind including landed property from individuals, benefactors, associations, organizations trusts, Government whether semi-Government municipal and other institutions whether from inside or outside India and to constitute a fund or to appropriate the corpus there of, for furthering the aims and objectives of the society.
- 2. To constitute and build up a contingency Fund in the name and account of the society so as to enable ANGNA to meet the expenses in the event of any emergency to meet any other contingencies relating to the objects of the society.

- 4. To raise funds by investing money of the Society in Sach matter as the Governing body shall from time to time deem fit, expendient and necessary and also to open and operate the account of the Society.
- 5. The Society shall function as a pholanthropic institution without any profit motive and shall employ its funds and surplus for furtherance of its objectives.

d. Legal.

- 1. To engage in any lawful activities for the betterment and protecting rights or defending the cause of the rural poor and also to provide forums of appeals or last appeal in disciplinary matters.
- 2. To institute prosecute and defend all such actions, suits and proceedings, revenue, civil and criminal as may be considered necessary, proper or expendient for furthering and promoting the objectives of the Society and/ or to compromise settle or refer the same to arbitration.
- 3. To negotiate and enter into aby agreement with the central and state Government, Municipality, voluntary organisations or any other civil bodies or private authorities, who subscribe to such similar property any other aims and objectives of the Society.

e. Discipline.

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To frame/amend code of conduct in the context of appointment transfer, disciplinary measures, service conditions, etc. for the employees of the Society.

f. Miscellaneous.

- 1. To present before the National and State conferences, commissions, committees or organisations and concerned departments, the aims and objectives of the society, if and when necessary for furtherance of the cause of the people.
- 2. To promote peace justice unity equality and fraternity communal love and harmony through education among the people irrespective of any caste, creed or culture for national integration.

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RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE ANGNA KAHUPANI.

Whereas the ANGNA Kahupani havining constituted itself into a society deems it expendient to framer Rules and Regulations with a view to carrying out the aims and objectives of the Society, the following Rules and Regulations are framed under part III (g) of the Memorandum of the Association of the said Society.

1. SHORT TITLE, EXTENT AND COMMENCEMENT.

 $\underline{\text{A.Name:-}}$ These rules shall be called, Rules and Regulations of the ANGNA Kahupani 1994.

- <u>b. Area of operation:-</u> The area of operation of the ANGNA Kahupani shall be the revenue district of Sundargarh in the state of Orissa.
- <u>c. Commencement:</u> These rules shall come into force from the day they are registered under the Society Registration Act 1860 (Act XXI of 1860)

2. AIMS AND OBJECTIVES.

The aims and objectives for which the Association is established are stated in paragraph III of the Memorandum of Association.

3. GOVERNING BODY.

The Governing body shall consist of five or more members of whom the under the mentioned five shall function as the executive committee.

- 1. President
- 2. Vice President
- 3. Secretary
- 4. Deputy Secretary
- 5. Treasurer

4. POWER OF THE GOVERNING BODY.

The Power of the society ANGNA Kahupani shall be exercised by the executive committee of the Society mentioned in Rule 3 above.

General: The Governing body shall have the faculty to do all such things for all such rural development activities defined here to before as may be necessary, expedient or incidental to the attainment of the aims and objectives of the Society or any of them namely:

- a. To draw, make accept, endores, discount, certificates, receipts Government notes, bills of exchange or other instruments and securities whether negotiable, transferable or not.
- b. To establish funds for rural development.
- c. To incur expenditure in sending employees, members, representatives to any place in such manner and extend as may be deemed necessary and expedient.
- d. To appoint or employ temporarily or permanently any person or persons including social workers or volunteers for doing the routine works of the society for the purpose of rural development by paying them salaries wages or keep person or persons of honoraria t the discretion of the executive committee.
- e. To open Bank account in the name of the society and to appoint personal to operate on the said bank account.
- f. To the name extent as natural person might or could do, to accept or acquire under the name the Association whether through purchase, lease, exchange, gift, grant, bequest, legacy or otherwise and to manage and hold all money and properties of any descriptions, movable or immovable which appears to be necessary or advantageous for the work of the Society.

g. To incur liabilities, make contracts or agreements, manage buildings constructions and to handle or carry transactions of any nature whether financial or otherwise relating to the interest of the Society.

To borrow or raise funds for corporate purposes of the society in such manner as it shall think fit to secure payment of the loans so borrowed or to secure the funds raised or owned by the society by mortgage charge or lien upon the whole or part of the society's properties or assets.

- i. To invest lay aside or otherwise deal with such money as are not immediately required for the work if the society and in particular to purchase, sell, endorse and negotiate in any way securities, stocks, bonds and shares if every ties description on the money market for and on behalf of the society.
- j. To take all necessary steps whether in court or out of court, to prosecute and to defend the rights and titles of the society in its properties whether movable or immovable.
- k. To prepare and receivable, release and other transactions of money payable to the society and for claims and demands of the society.
- 1. To delegate any or some of its powers to committees consisting of such members or members of the governing body, including the office bearers or non-office bearers of the society as the governing body/executive committee may think fit and proper and the committee so formed shall not-with-standing the powers so delegate, conformed to any regulation, that may be imposed upon it by the governing body but nothing in these presents shall be construed in any manner, so as to give the committee, any power of management over the society, which are exclusively vested in the governing body however the governing body may at any time withdraw any power delegated to such committee.
- m. To do all things and every things necessary, suitable, proper for the promotion or accomplishment of any of the purpose of objectives of the society or for the furtherance of any powers set forth in these presents, either alone or in conjunction with other societies, corporations, firms or individuals.

ii. Financial assistance.

a. To avail financial assistance as far as possible and practicable for the effective management and financial viability of the projects for rural development and for the purpose to assist in getting such financial or other support from private and public sectors including government, semi-government, municipal and other local bodies and national or international agencies or organizations.

b. To invest and deal with funds and resources of further the aims and objectives of the society.

c. To issue appeals and make or prepare applications for the purpose of procuring contributions to the funds of the society in shape of grant-in-aid, donations, subscriptions or otherwise in all cases for developmental purposes only.

iii.Property

- a. To receive aid in cash or kind or any gift of movable and immovable property with or without any specific conditions which may be acceptable to the governing body.
- b. To purchase, movable and immovable property including securities and other investments so as to keep the funds of the society profitably invested and employed for the benefits of the society.
- c. To sell, assign, mortage, lease, exchange or otherwise transfer or dispose of such property movable or immovable of the society for the furtherance of the society's aims and objectives as and when necessary.
- d. To acquire movable and immovable property by purchase, lease, hire, exchange or otherwise in places where, the activities of the society may extend.

To build, construct, maintain, repair, alter, improve, mdify or and argarh pull down any building or constructions and to equip the same with electricity, water, drainage, furniture, fittings instruments and appliances as may be necessary or convenient for the purpose of the society..

iv. Management of other funds.

To undertaken or accept management of any endowments, or trust, funds or donations to further the aims and objectives of the society on such terms/or conditions as may be agreed upon and not otherwise.

v. The governing body shall have the power to amend or to add to or make any alternations in or modifications of the memorandum of Association or any of the foregoin rules and regulations in as extraordinary

Ponal Cof Billy Secretary ANGNA, Kahup meeting of the governing body, convened for the purpose by a majority of 2/3 members present and voting provided that no addition to or modifications shall be made which may have a direct effect of subverting any one or more of the aims and objectives of the society.

5. ADVISORY COMMITTEE OF THE SOCIETY.

The advisory committee of the society shall consist of the office bearer of the Executive committee and 25 nominate members subscribing to the memorandum of association of the ANGNA Kahupani. The tenure of the advisory committee shall be concurrent with the tenure of the Executive Committee. However, vacancies if and when arises hereafter, though cessation of office, death, retirement, expulsion etc. shall be filled up by the president of the said society. Not with standing however, the president may also co-opt, nominate or appoint from among the village committee members, representatives of developmental committees etc. and for that matter constitute standing panels of consultative committee aid and advise the society in furtherance of its aims and objectives. However, the members so nominated or appointed shall not have the right to vote in meetings of the society.

6. POWER OF EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE.

- 1.a. The executive committee in addition to the powers and authority expressly or otherwise conferred upon it, as hereunder, may exercise all such powers on behalf of the society and do all such act and things which may be proper and expedient for the furtherance of the aim and objectives of the society.
- 1.b. The executive committee may constitute sub-committee ad may be necessary and expedient for specific purposes and terms, which shall be accountable to the executive committee. The chairman of the sub-committee shall ordinarily be member of the executive committee. Sub-committee adverted above are as hereunder:-
- i. Planning sub-committee.
- ii. Finance sub-committee.
- iii. Disciplinary sub-committee.
- iv. Legal Aid sub-committee.

vi. Educational sub-committee.

The sub-committee shall have standing instructions from the Executive committee and shall submit their report in matters referred to them, through the chairman of the sub-committee to the Secretary of the executive committee.

- 1.c. The executive committee may authorise the committee to make rules and regulations for the better and proper management of projects and other activities undertaken by the society.
- 1.d. For ensuring compliance with its directives, members of the executive committee, members of any of the sub-committee mentioned and/or any other representatives expressly authorised by the executive committee on this behalf are empowered to visit with due notice/or without, affiliated institutions (if any) and other relavant places and conduct such inspections of records, documents, books of account, etc or to carry out investigations, as deemed necessary and expedient for these purposes, including the recording of statements on interrogations as deemed necessary and expedient for these purposes, including the recording statement on interrogations or otherwise by the concerned members, employees, other consituents or any person who may in any way, be concerned with activities of the society.

7.OFFICE BEARER OF THE EXECUTIVE COMMITTE.

The executive committee of the society shall have president, vice-president, Secretaty, Deputy secretaty, Treasurer. The president, vice president, Secretary, Deputy secretaty and treasurer shall be among the members who will be elected in the general body meeting and the term of their office will be for three years.

8. POWER AND FUNCTIONS OF THE OFFICE BEARERS.

1. President:-

- a. He shall preside over all the meetings of the ANGNA.
- b. He shall supervise the general administration of the ANGNA.
- c. He shall be final disciplinary authority in the disciplinary measurers in respect of employees of ANGNA.
- d. He shall be responssible for keeping the securities of the society in the safe custody.
- e. He shall have power to convene special meetings of the ANGNA or the governing body, besides the schedules ones.
- f. He shall have power to act on behalf of the ANGNA and to sanction expenditure.

ii.Vice President

He shall preside over the meetings of the governing body and executive committee of the society during the absence of the president.

iii.Secretary.

- a. He shall under the direction of the president, issue notices and the agenda of the ordinary as well as, special meetings of the ANGNA.
- b. He shall be responssible to record the minutes of the meetings of the ANGNA and take out the extract of the same and attest them as such.
- c. He shall receive all papers and correspondence on behalf of the ANGNA and submit for the consideration of the governing body, or executive committee when necessary.
- d. He shall sign all correspondence on behalf of ANGNA.
- e. He shall be in-charge of records, papers, furnitures and other movable properties, belonging to the office of the ANGNA and shall maintain the Registers and files up-to date.
- f. He shall sign the service books, entries of appointments, transfers, reliefs etc of the employees of the ANGNA.
- g. He shall be under the guidance of the president and transuct all departmental works in the office of the concerned departmental authorities.
- h. The secretary shall exercise all such poowers, and do all such acts, as may be required for the proper conduct of the society as may be directed by the governing body.

iv. Deputy secretary.

a. He shall perform those duties of the secretary which assigned to him in writing by the president of the society.

b. In the absence of the secretary, he shall carry on all functions of the secretary.

v.Treasurer

- a. He shall have the custody of the funds and valuable documents of ANGNA.
- b. He shall diligently look after the financial and other interests of the society and shall be responssible for the custody and maintanance of the account books and cash entrusted to him.
- c. He shall be responssible for arranging the Audit of the society if and when requied. The accounts of the society maintained in Bank or scheduled Banks shall be operated by president of the society.
- d. He shall be responssible for maintaining the bank accouts of the society, in the name of the president of the society and for keeping the securities of the society in safe custody.

9. MEETINIG: GOVERNING BODY.

The members of the governing body may meet together for the dispatch of the business of the society, adjourn and otherwise regulate their meetings as they may think fit, observing however the following:-

ddl. Registra

- a. Chairman: The chairman of the meetings of the governing bodyof the society shall be the president, if present but in absence the vice president.
- b. Quorum: The quorum necessary for the meeting of the governing body and for the transaction of the business of the society will be 2/3. bresend in the meeting blias Tiggs
- c. Majority: The question arising or a meeting shall be decided by a majority of votes whether on show of hands or at a poll, but in case of even numbers of votes the chairman shall have a second or casting votes.
- d. Votes: At all meetings of the governing body or of any comittee thereof every member of the governing body or committee, whether present personally orby proxy and whether on show of hands of at a poll shall have one vote except the president who in case of tie has a second vote.

10. EXECUTIVE BODY DIRECTOR

To execute the plans/programmes/project of the society in a competent way the executive committee body will appointed persons who is qualified to execute the plans/programmes/projects of the society. The whole administration responssibilities of the society will be with the director.

Power of the executive Director:-

- 1. As a competent authority he can make plans/programmes/projects of ANGNA.
- 2. He can execute plans/programmes/projects for ANGNA.
- 3. He will be responssible to use the funds of the society for the specific purpose of the society.
- 4. He will direct/guide the staff/employees of the society as time to time the society may give guide lines.
- 5. He will time to time report the activities of the executive body to the governing body.
- 6. He may establish funds for the rural development purpose.
- 7. He may be authorised to sign on behalf of the society for same specific ppurpose.

11.ANNUAL MEETING

Once every year during the month of Aprol there shall be summoned an Annual General Meeting of the Memers of the Association to receive the Annual report.

12. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE MEETING.

The members of the executive committee will be held as often as necessary or at the direction of the president at the short notice if necessary to deal with the urgent matters arising in the mean time.

a.Quorum of the executive meeting:— The quorum of the executive committee meeting will be five entitled to vote upon being personally present. If at the meeting called the quorum is not available the meeting may be adjourned for fifteen minuts the same day and place, however, if a quorum is not available on such second occasion, business of the Meeting may be transacted without the normal quorum. Any sub-committee formed for the specific purpose of the society should be ordinarily follow the procedure set for the deliberation of the executive committee

b. Terms of office:— The first executive committee will hold office for three years and the term of every subsequent executive committee members shall ordinarily be three years.

Each shall however, continue to hold office for further term od six months, unless the president so direct the election of the Executive Members should be held at the end of three years during the following six months time. In case of any vacancy created due to some reason president will appoint any member of the ANGNA to fill up the vacancy.

12.MEMBERSHIP

Person who is willing to work for the rural development and only those six persons from a village could be the members of ANGNA who are selected by the villagers as their representatives of their village to ANGNA for the development of their oown village and also for the development of other people who are in need. They become membership by paying membership fees Rs.20/ and will have to renew their membership every year by paying Rs. 20/ as renewal fees.

13. CEASATION OF MEMBERSHIP.

The membership shall cease upon:-

- 1. Death or notification by a member concerning his/her intention to withdraw from the membership.
- 2. Expulsion by the executive committee on charge of non-compliance with the directive of the society or any other action or activities which the executive body considers to be derogatory to the standing istruction/rules/orders of the society or for any other which the committee feels.

14.AUDIT AND ACCOUNT:-

The account of the society shall be annually audited by the chattered accountant or registered auditers who shall be appointed by the president/by the Government auditor blias Tiggs

15.NOTICE FOR PROPOSED AMENDMENT:-

Any member desirous of proposing any changes in the MEMORANDUM of the association and/ or rules and Regulations of the society, shall give at least fifteen days clear notice of such proposal to the Secretary in writing duly signed by the proposer and

16. JUDICIAL NATURE OF THE SOCIETY:-

The society may sue or sued, in the name of the ANGNA or any other person as shall be appointed of the governing body for a particular case.

17.SEAL:-

There shall be a common seal of the society and individual seals for president, secretary and treasurer for the office use only.

18. DISSOLUTION:-

- 1. Should the society/committee fail to achieve its aims and objectives or neglect to safeguard the rights and interest of its members continuent or do any act determental to its existence or continuance thereof, the president is empowered is empowered to dissolve the Association.
- disbanding dissolution upon or Association/society/committee there remains any property the satisfaction of all its debts and liabilities, the same shall not be paid or distributed among the members of the society but shall be given or transfered to any charitable institution, which the governing body decides upon.
